Theo Schuyt

Since 2001, professor Theo N.M. Schuyt holds the “Philanthropic Studies” chair at Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam; the first chair on philanthropy in The Netherlands and the European Union. He is the founder of the “Giving the Netherlands” (GIN) research project, started in 1995. His major fields of research are philanthropy, social policy, the Welfare State, foundations and social innovation.

President of the European Research Network on Philanthropy (ERNOP), Theo is also the director of the “Giving Europe”/ “Philanthropy in Europe” project of ERNOP. Besides, he is a member of the Advisory Board of the National Gaming Authority (Kansspelautoriteit), and an adviser on several Community Foundations in the Netherlands.

Laurence de Nervaux

A graduate from Ecole Normale Supérieure, Sciences Po (Paris) and Princeton (USA), Laurence started her career at the French Institute Alliance Française in NY, and then at the Center of national monuments in Paris.

Since 2013, she has been the head of the Observatory of philanthropy at Fondation de France, the leading philanthropy network in France. The Observatory analyses the volume and trends of private philanthropy in France and Europe, and promotes its development. At Fondation de France, Laurence also supervises the School of philanthropy, an awareness program for school children, and she is in charge of institutional and international affairs. She is a member of the scientific committee of the French association for the development of data on social economy, and the author of several related contributions and articles. Laurence teaches a graduate class at Sciences Po on philanthropy and public policies.
